## What the program is and where to find it online

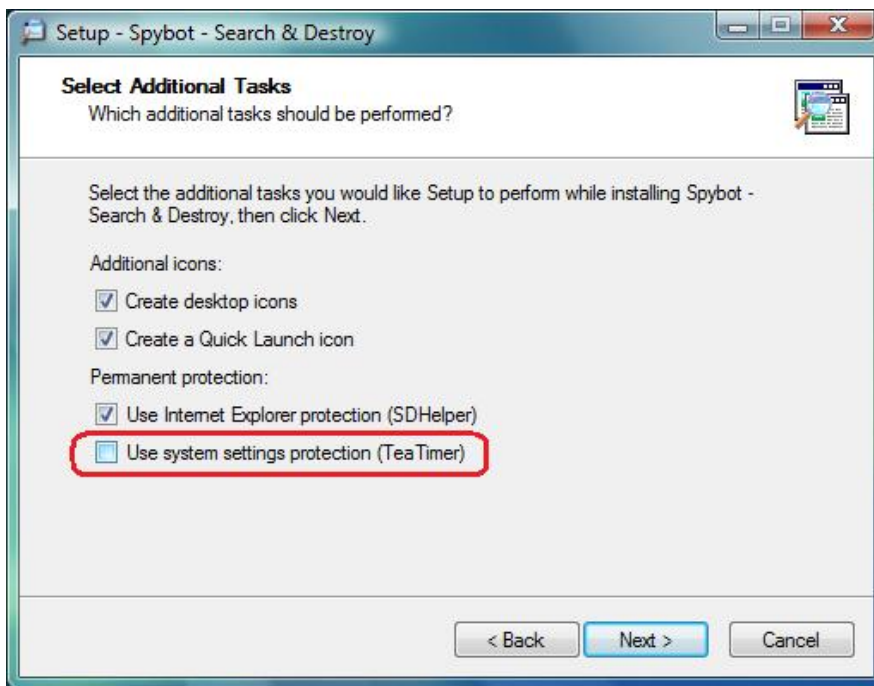
Spybot: Search and Destroy is another utility for spyware removal. It is more complicated to install and use than Anti-Malware or Super Anti-Spyware, and can be more problematic during the removal process. Spybot's homepage can be found at:

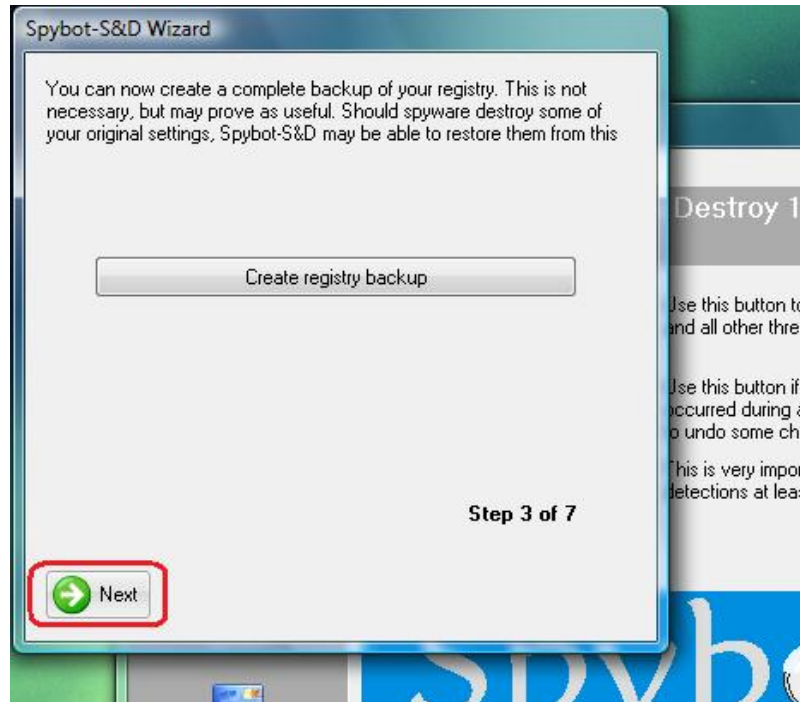
## Installation Note

The installation moves along like just about any other until you reach this screen. Here, make absolutely sure that you *uncheck* the box beside "Use system settings protection (TeaTimer)." After that is done, complete the installation.



## Using the program

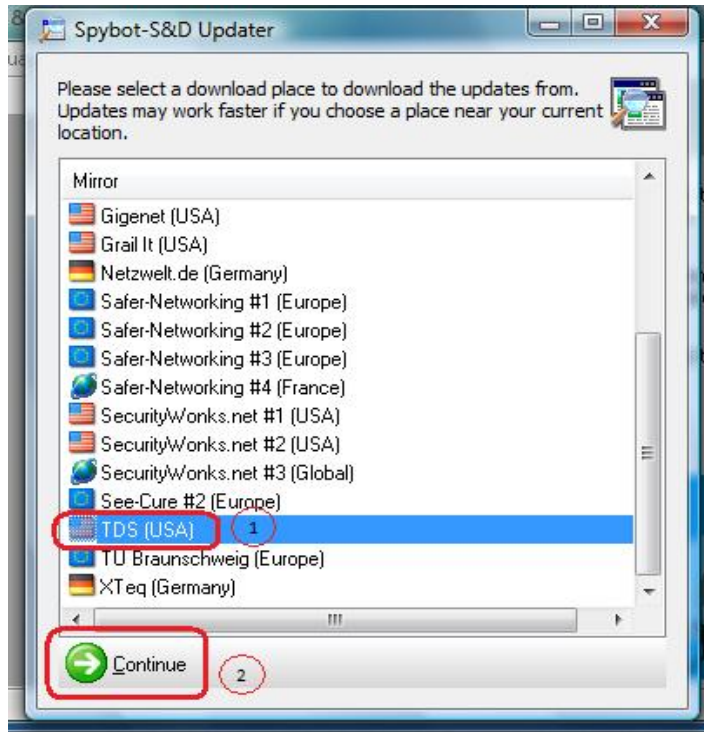
As soon as the home screen is displayed, a popup window also displays that prompts you to go through a series of steps before using the program. The first of which is to create a backup of the registry. We usually don't do this, so just click "Next." This will skip ahead to the end, and you can then click the option to begin using the program. Now you can navigate around the home screen.



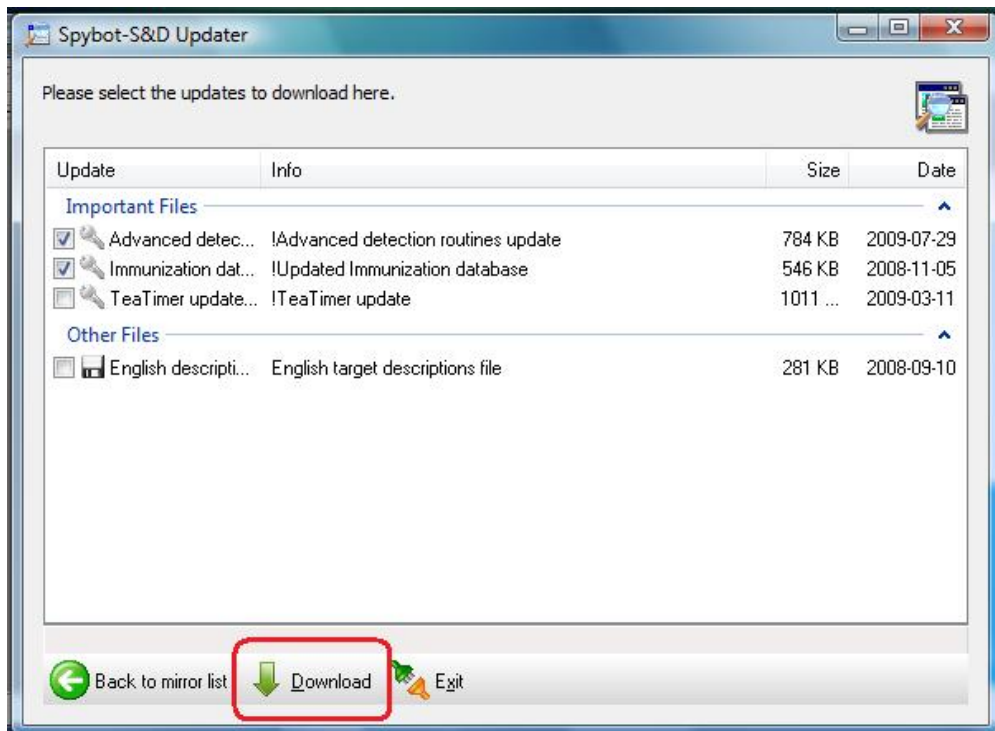
The home screen has two main options of interest: "Check for Problems" (1) and "Search for Updates" (2). Obviously, it is always best to update the program before using it, so click "Search for Updates."



This will now display a list of mirrors from which to pull definitions. Select one (a good one is TDS) and click "Continue."



Now you will need to select the updates to get. Make sure to uncheck the boxes for TeaTimer updates. Once all have been selected, click "Download" to get the updates.



Once the

updates have been

installed, you can begin scanning. From the home screen, click "Check for Problems." The scan automatically starts and all you need to do is wait. Once the scan is complete, remove the problems. However, most of the time, Spybot requires a restart to get rid of the problems. But it also prompts you to run the scan again while the computer starts up.
